#### **Principles of Sowing and Reaping**

If you are a student of the Scriptures you have probably noticed its frequent use of agricultural imagery. During biblical times people lived close to the land. Not so in our day. Most of us sit down to eat giving little or no thought to where our food came from or how it was produced.






