Please prayerfully consider receiving a special offering for these agencies on these days.

The first offering is **February 28 for Welch College.** I was thrilled to learn about the special gift a foundation gave to Welch College to establish an M.Div. Program. It is encouraging to see those outside the denomination recognize the importance of the type of education Welch College provides. When you receive an offering for Welch, you make an investment that will pay dividends. Also, please encourage your congregation to pray for Welch students as they return to campus. Please participate in the **World Missions Offering on April 25.** Because of COVID, last year's offering was delayed until August. It may feel like your church just participated in the offering, but this is an important component to meeting their financial needs. I encourage you to invite missionaries and IM personnel to your churches or to allow them to share their story remotely via Skype or Zoom. All of us have received the charge to reach the world with the gospel (Acts 1:8b). I know of no other way to fulfill that charge without working together to send those willing to go. Please do not forget the **Rest of the Family Offering on September 26.** It is easy to overlook the importance of these groups. The offering is divided between the Board of Retirement, Executive Office, Free Will Baptist Foundation, Vertical Three, WNAC, and the commissions (Theological, Historical, Media, and Music). These groups provide much training and support to the denomination. The better they are funded, the better they can support and partner with our churches, many of which are struggling and in need of help. The pandemic has wreaked havoc on the publishing ministry. Vertical Three is the arm of Randall House that operates CTS, Truth & Peace, and other ministries. Vertical Three receives a small part of the Rest of the Family offering, which is used to assist with the expenses of the Vertical Three Conference. Finally, we have the offering for **North American Ministries on November 21**. Please participate in this offering. NAM has church planters, chaplains, and cross-cultural ministry partners across North America, most in the United States. We believe the hope for the United States is in transforming communities through the gospel. These church planters are working in areas without evangelical churches to sustain the population of that community. NAM and the Executive Office have also developed Refresh, which is a way to provide resources for all of our churches. In 2020, Dr. Danny Dwyer scheduled to train 32 coaches to help with church revitalization.
