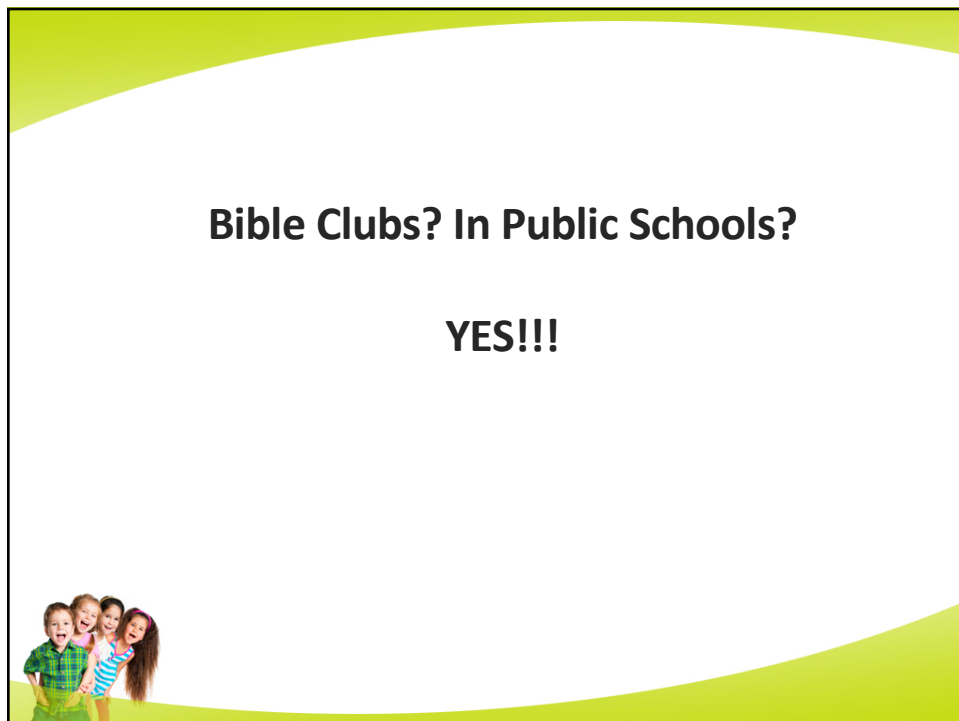

How can we teach the Bible in public schools?

In 2001 the United States Supreme Court ruled in *Good News Clubs v. Milford Central School* that Good News Clubs can meet in public schools in the United States after school hours on the same terms as other community groups.

What is a Good News Club?

Good News Club is a ministry of *Child Evangelism Fellowship* (CEF)

The purpose of *Good News Club* is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and establish (disciple) them in the Word of God and in a local church for Christian living.

1. To win kids to Christ.
2. To disciple them in His Word.
3. To connect them to a local church.

Best Scenario

A church which already has a relationship or partnership with a school takes another step in that relationship with a Good News Club.

How can our church start a Good News Club?

Possible Scenario

A church which wants to start a partnership with a local school, takes a step of faith and begins a club.

How can our church start a Good News Club?

1. Ask the principal of the school if it would be possible to start a club at their school.
Decide on day with principal.
2. Begin to recruit club team members from your church or couple of churches.
3. Schedule a training day with a local or regional CEF staff member.
4. Begin the club in September, end the club in April.
