- 3. To connect them to a local church.



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
How can our church start a Good News Club?

Best Scenario

A church which already has a relationship or partnership with a school takes another step in that relationship with a Good News Club.



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How can our church start a Good News Club?

 Ask the principal of the school if it would be possible to start a club at their school.
Decide on day with principal.

2. Begin to recruit club team members from your church or couple of churches.

3. Schedule a training day with a local or regional CEF staff member.

4. Begin the club in September, end the club in April.
