HOW DO I START?

- 1. Contact the Executive Office and we will help match you to a Rekindle coach. The coach will arrange a preliminary visit.
- 2. Prayerfully set a date for the coach's church assessment.
- 3. The pastor and local church leaders decide to partner with Rekindle according to the results of the church assessment.

 The assessment tool is a questionnaire relating to the ten strategies of Rekindle.

 All who regularly attend the church are encouraged to participate. This gives insights into the present perceptions of the church. The assessment tool helps identify the most-needed areas to be addressed throughout the Rekindle process.
- 4. The pastor and church leaders choose a team to represent the church in meeting with the coach over a six-month period for "Rekindle Basic."
- 5. Dates are set for the implementation of "Rekindle Basic." An additional six months is optional for implementation.

EXPENSES

The church and Rekindle coach determine the costs based on the church budget with the goal of providing for the expenses of the coach and an honorarium.

COACHING

Coaching is available to pastors and churches who would like hands-on assistance. Coaching can be especially valuable to new pastors and to churches in transition.

A 2019 study on Free Will Baptist churches conducted by the Committee on Denominational Research indicated that 58% of Free Will Baptist churches had plateaued and 29% were declining.



Some churches will soon close unless they intentionally choose biblical principles of renewal to regain spiritual health. Rekindle coaching can be the resource they need. Rekindle helps churches identify and implement these principles.

In 2020, Dr. Danny Dwyer, the administrator of Rekindle, trained 33 coaches. He plans to train

15 more in 2021. These coaches use proven techniques based on biblical principles.
