We overcome by *Being Good Stewards* with every individual, every church, and our denomination, using what God has given us to reach the world. Finally, we overcome by *Reaching Out to All* and inviting them to the Great Banquet.

If we heed the messages this week, we will be different people, better-equipped churches, a healthier denomination, and a different nation.

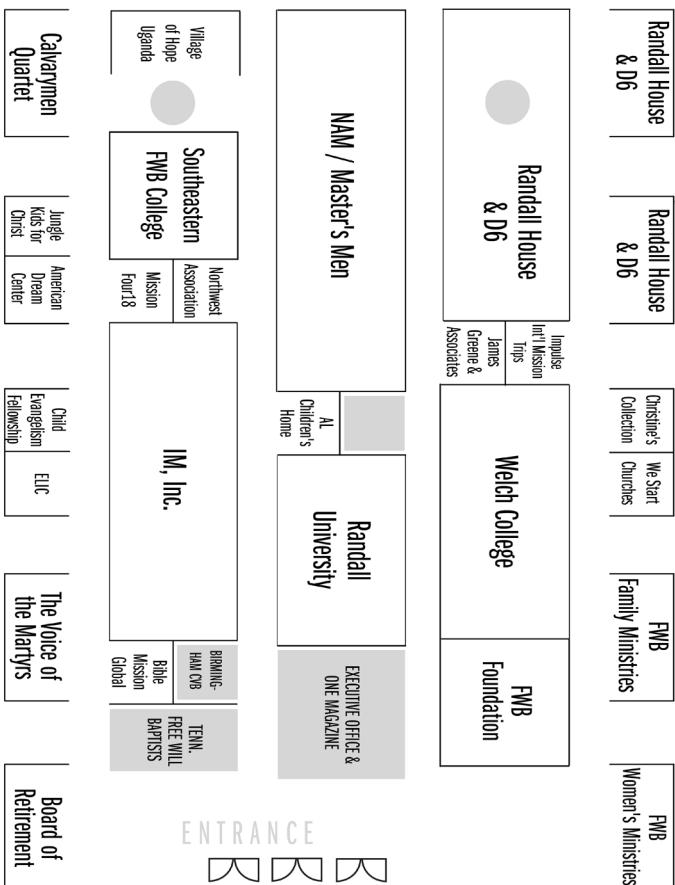

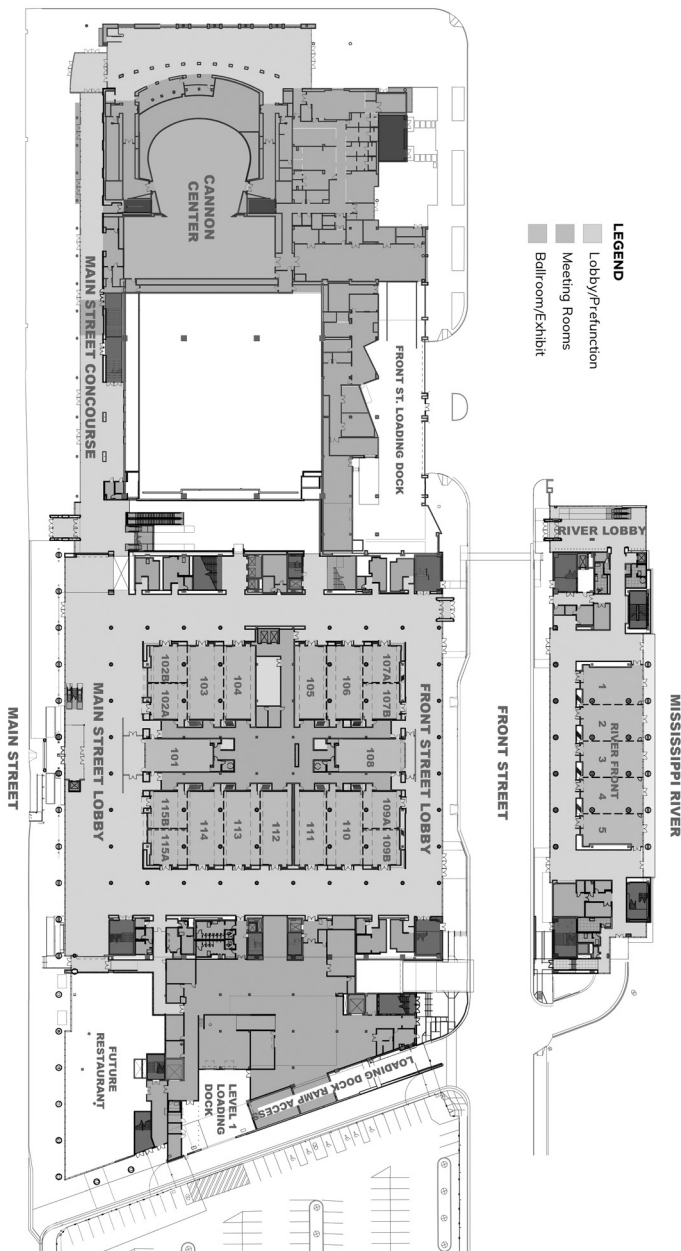

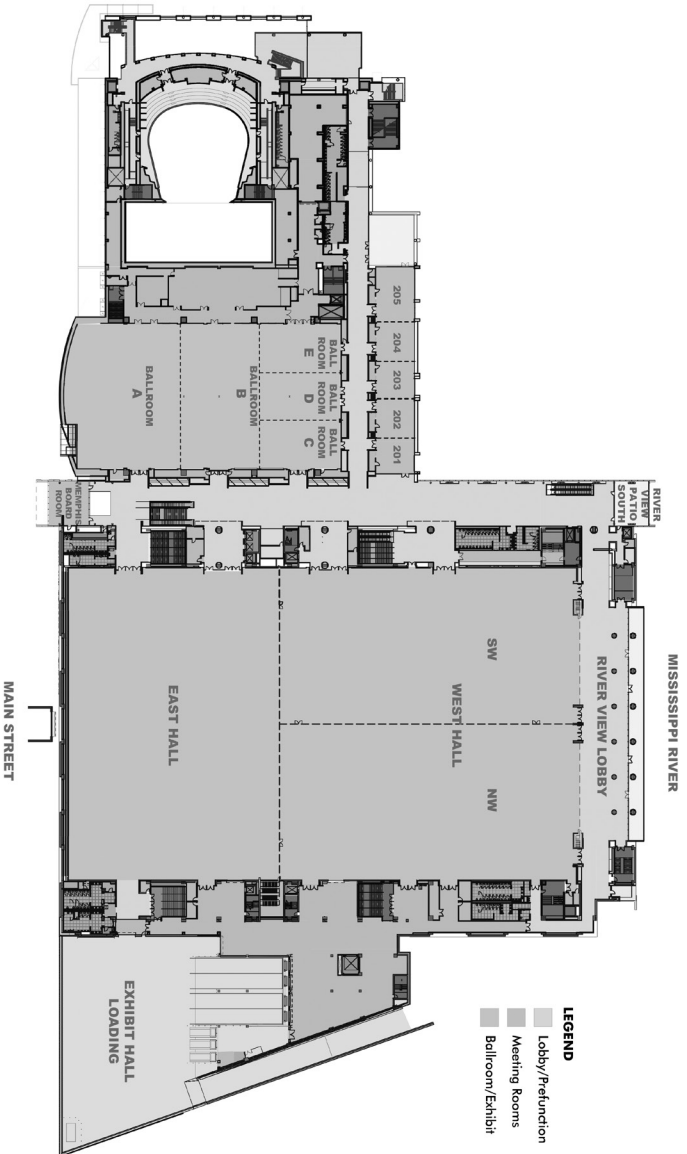
