
The first offering is **February 27 for Welch College.** Welch College is training the next generation of leaders in Free Will Baptist doctrine and practice. Exciting things are happening at Welch. They have a new accelerated Master of Divinity program that can be completed in only five years and has been approved by SACSCOC. The **Rest of the Family Offering is now April 24.** The offering is divided among the Executive Office, WNAC, FWB Foundation, Board of Retirement, Vertical Three, and the commissions (Theological, Historical, Media, and Music). These important ministries provide training and support to the denomination, equipping Free Will Baptists to give their best to the Lord's work. The Executive Office provides resources to help churches reach others and train congregants (nafwb.org/3for30). The Refresh program, offered by the Executive Office and North American Ministries, provides free coaching and other resources. Learn more at nafwb.org/Refresh. WNAC provides a plethora of resources at wnac.org. Vertical Three is the department of Randall House that operates CTS, Truth & Peace, and more. IM is actively involved in reaching the world with the gospel and training churches to fulfill the Great Commission. **Note the new date of the World Missions Offering (WMO): August 28.** Despite the pandemic, three IM couples and their families went to their fields of service for the first time in 2021. I encourage you to invite missionaries and IM personnel to your churches or to allow them to share their stories remotely. The **offering for North American Ministries (NAM) is November 20.** NAM currently has 47 church planters throughout North America. Most of these new churches are being launched in cities with large, growing populations yet few Bible-believing churches. We believe the hope for our nation is communities transformed by the gospel. NAM also has 11 chaplains providing important ministry to the military. Master's Men, an arm of NAM, has been active in disaster response, helping churches and individuals impacted by tornadoes and other natural disasters.
