Go the Extra Mile

If there ever was a time when the world needed Christians to go the extra mile, it is now. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus commanded His disciples to go the extra mile in their daily lives, and it is what He also calls us to do. As we gather this week, each speaker will challenge us to go the extra mile.

How do we make going the extra mile part of our DNA? We practice going the extra mile as we *practice forgiveness*. This is never clearer than in the picture of the Prodigal Son. We go the extra mile by *protecting our brother*; being alert for how our actions impact other brothers and sisters in Christ. We go the extra mile by *reaching the hurting*, as Jesus made it part of His life to always have time for those who are hurting. We go the extra mile by *reaching the hard to reach*, as Jesus did when he intentionally went to Sychar and engaged the Samaritan woman. Finally, we go the extra mile by *reaching all the world*. Increasingly, the world is coming to our doorstep, and we must adapt as Peter did to take the Gospel to Cornelius.

Last year as we met in Memphis, many of our attendees went the extra mile by engaging the people of that city. It is my prayer we do the same this week in Birmingham, and that when we leave the city there will be a longing for us to return.

As we go back to our homes, our churches, and our communities, may we truly make going the extra mile the norm for how we live our lives. If we do, just like those early disciples did, we will see our communities turned upside down.

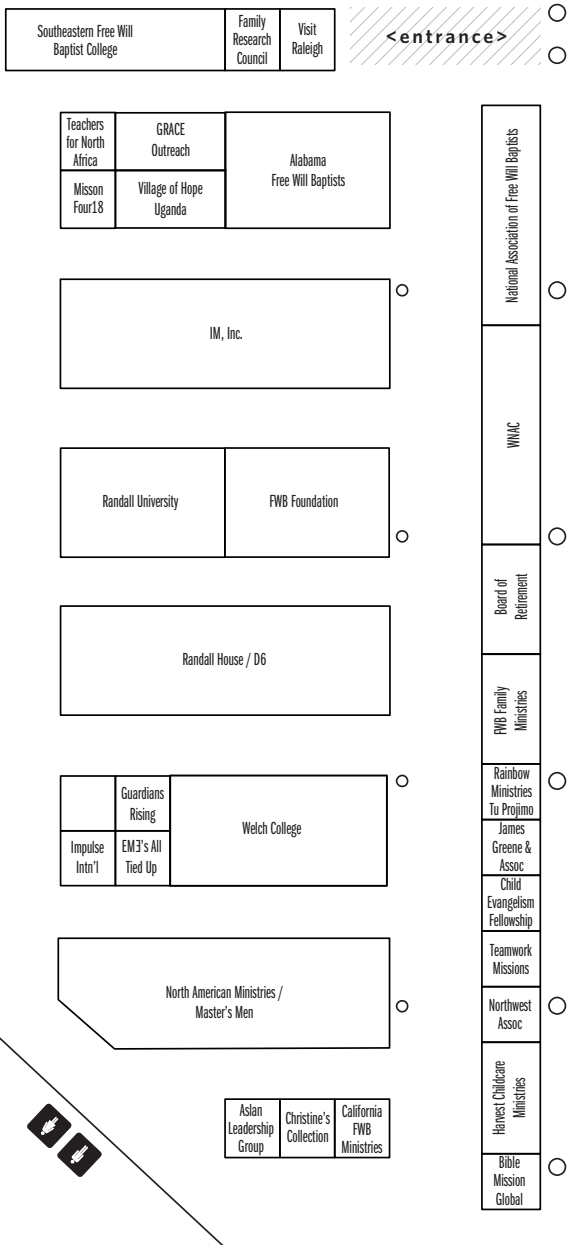

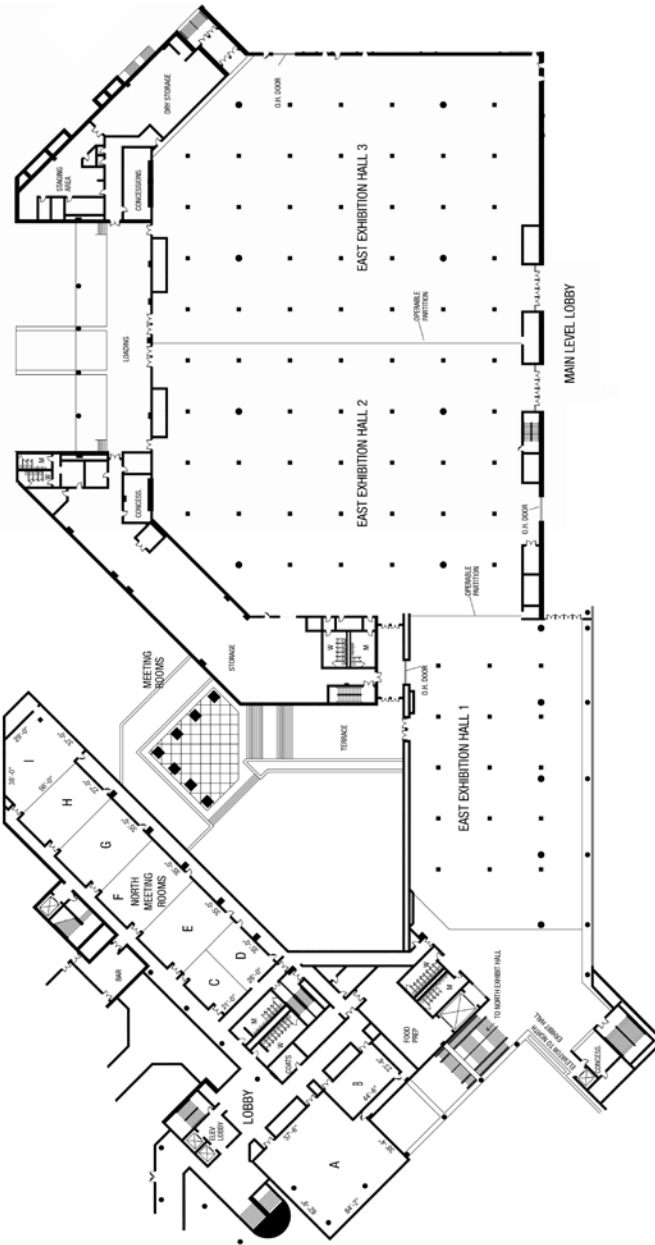

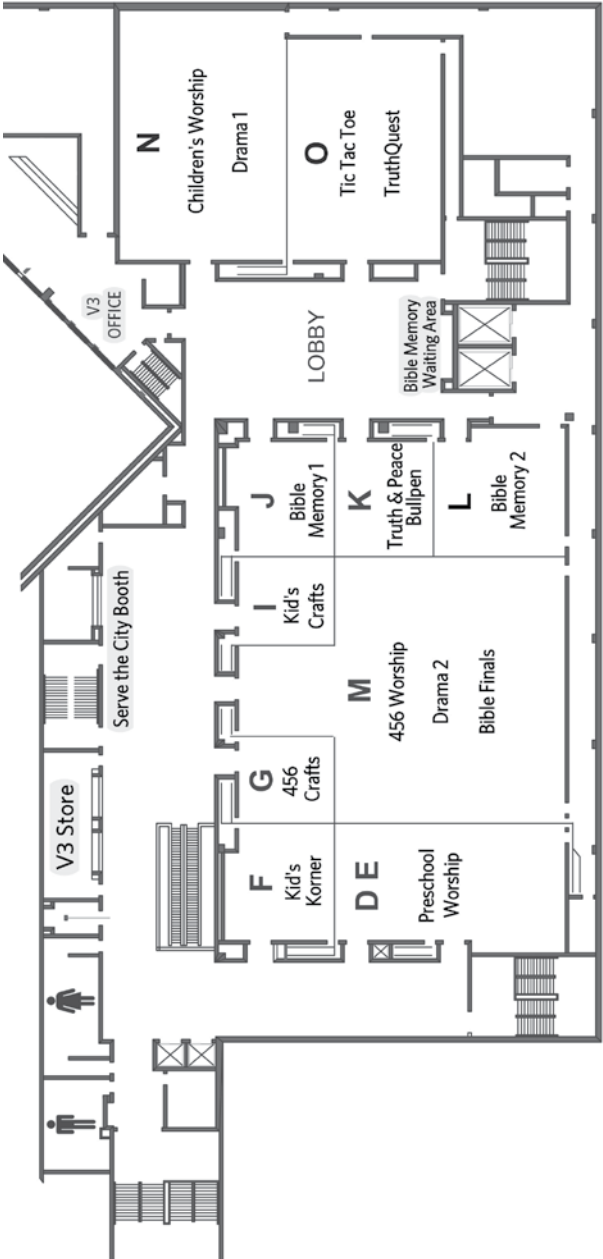
