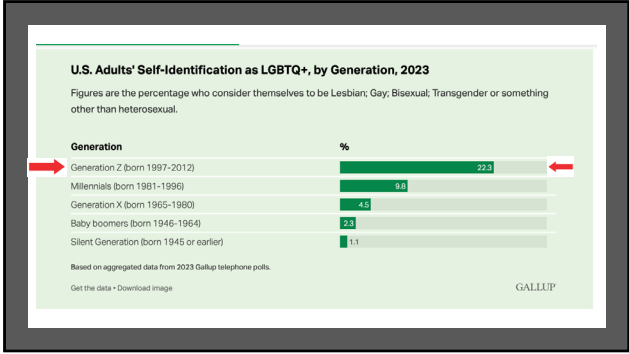

Can Some Gay Men and Lesbians Change Their Sexual Orientation? 200 Participants Reporting a Change from Homosexual to Heterosexual Orientation¹

Position statements of the major mental health organizations in the United States state that there is no scientific evidence that a homosexual sexual orientation can be changed by psychotherapy, often referred to as "reparative therapy." This study tested the hypothesis that some individuals whose sexual orientation is predominantly homosexual can, with some forms of reparative therapy, become predominantly heterosexual. The participants were 200 self-selected individuals (143 males, 57 females) who reported at least some initial change from homosexual to heterosexual orientation that lasted at least 5 years. They were interviewed by telephone, using a structured interview that assessed rates of attraction, fantasy, yearning, and overt homosexual behavior. On all measures, the year prior to the therapy was compared to the year before the interview. The majority of participants gave reports of change from a predominantly or exclusively homosexual orientation before therapy to a predominantly or exclusively heterosexual orientation in the past year. Reports of complete change were uncommon. Female participants reported significantly more change than did male participants. Either were gay men and lesbians, following reparative therapy, actually change their predominantly homosexual orientation to a predominantly heterosexual orientation or some gay men and women construct elaborate self-deceptive narratives (or even lies) to which they claim to have changed their sexual orientation, or both. Spitzer Issues Apology for Study Supporting Reparative Therapy

Despite methodological limitations, Robert Spitzer, M.D.'s, study on efficacy of reparative therapy was widely cited by its own phrasing as evidence of the therapy's effectiveness, but was criticized as harmful to gays and lesbians.

It is the latest turn in a now 30-plus year evolution in psychiatry's understanding of homosexuality and involves a figure who has been prominent in that story throughout.

Robert Spitzer, M.D., well known to APA members as a leader in the development of DSM, recovered as instrumental in removing homosexuality from the diagnostic manual as a disorder in 1973 and—paradoxically—the author of a deeply controversial study in the early part of the last decade suggesting that "reparative therapy" could help gay people change their sexual orientation—has now renounced the findings of that controversial study.

In a letter to the editor of the *Archives of Sexual Behavior*, where the study appeared in 2003, Spitzer issued a mea culpa. "I believe I owe the gay community an apology for my study making unproven claims of the efficacy of reparative therapy," he wrote. "I also apologize to any gay...

Gender Dysphoria in Children (6 or more of the following for at least 6 months)

1. A strong desire to be of the other gender or an insistence that one is the other gender
2. In boys (assigned gender), a strong preference for cross-dressing or simulating female attire; or in girls (assigned gender), a strong preference for wearing only typical masculine clothing and a strong resistance to wearing typical feminine clothing
3. A strong preference for cross-gender roles in make-believe play or fantasy play
4. A strong preference for toys, games, or activities stereotypically used or engaged in by the other gender
5. A strong preference for playmates of the other gender
6. In boys (assigned gender), a strong rejection of typically masculine toys, games, and activities and a strong rejection of rough-and-tumble play; or in girls (as assigned gender), a strong rejection of typically feminine toys, games, and activities
7. A strong dislike for one's sexual anatomy
8. A strong desire for the primary and/or secondary sex characteristic that match one's experienced gender

Gender Dysphoria in Adolescents and Adults (2 or more of the following for at least 6 months)

1. A marked incongruence between one's experienced/expressed gender and primary and/or secondary sex characteristics (or in young adolescents, the anticipated secondary sex characteristics)
2. A strong desire to be rid of one's primary and/or secondary sex characteristics because of a marked incongruence with one's experienced/expressed gender (or in young adolescents, a desire to prevent the development of the anticipated secondary sex characteristics)
3. A strong desire for the primary and/or secondary sex characteristics of the other gender
4. A strong desire to be treated as the other gender (or some alternative gender different from one's assigned gender)
5. A strong desire to be treated as the other gender (or some alternative gender different from one's assigned gender)
6. A strong conviction that one has the typical feelings and reactions of the other gender (or some alternative gender different from one's assigned gender)
