Accept the Mission

Though the book of Jonah was written centuries ago, its message is as pertinent today as it was then. We too have a mission in a world seemingly turned upside down. This week, we will be challenged to accept that mission.

We will begin Sunday morning with a joint teen and adult Sunday School and worship service. We will focus on how to **Build**, **Plant**, **and Seek Peace as Your Mission in a World Turned Upside Down**. We are called to settle down, build a life, and seek the welfare of the city where God has placed us.

On Sunday evening we will turn to Jonah and ask, **When God Calls**, **Will You Accept the Mission?** God has called us to be His ambassadors which may be out of our comfort zone. Try as we might to avoid it, we can't ignore God's mission.

Jonah is an example of a man who paid dearly for failing to accept God's mission. What are the consequences for disobeying God's mission? What can we do if we have intentionally disobeyed God? We will seek to answer those questions Monday evening by exploring *When Disobeying Your Mission Sinks You.*

Next, we will reflect on **God's Mission for the Reluctant**, noting God can use us even if we have been unwilling to fulfill His mission—if we are finally willing to let Him use us.

Finally, on Wednesday the teens and adults will come together again for our mission service as we consider God's desire to involve us in His mission of mercy to the world, just as He involved Jonah in His mission to Nineveh. You will be challenged to *Fulfill Your Mission: Love People Like God Loves Them.*

I hope your time in Kansas City will be a special time. I trust all of us will come together to *accept our mission* to reach a world that desperately needs the Lord.


