



Recommended Resources for Individuals Pursuing Ordination to Pastoral Ministry

The listing below includes resources to help develop the knowledge and skills of the person seeking licensing as a minister of the gospel. Compared to the enormous responsibility of shepherding a congregation, this rather short list just begins to introduce a life-long commitment of self discipleship. As the primary spiritual leader and teacher, a candidate should be familiar with multiple categories such as Free Will Baptist theology, history, and polity. Just as 1 Timothy 3 broadens the requirements, a well rounded minister should also incorporate philosophy of ministry, apologetics, worldview, along with discipleship and leadership. Some of these resources are designed for group study which will help the candidate develop their ability to teach others. The reading list leads the candidate through a balanced and logical progression of subject matter over a 12 month period.

The list for Level 2 builds upon the understanding developed through the Level 1 resources. At this level it is assumed the candidate has read the titles from the licensing reading list, developed the biblical framework to begin thinking as a pastor, and contextualized what is read toward application to ministry in a local church.

It should be understood and reinforced by clergy review boards how these lists can help develop understanding of knowing and serving God through pastoral ministry. Such resources are preparatory and foundational for a life of cultivating the call and gifting of pastoral ministry.
