






### STORY HIGHLIGHTS

"Quiet quitters" make up at least 50% of the U.S. workforce -- probably more, Gallup finds.











## 1 big thing: Police struggle with staffing

**Police departments across the country** are facing severe staffing shortages as they struggle to recruit and retain officers, *Axios'* Ivana Saric reports.

- **Why it matters:** The shortages have coincided with a [spike](#) in crime across the nation.

**In Denver**, firearm homicides [surged](#) in 2021, more than double the 2015 total.

## The health worker shortage is starting to get real for Americans



The health worker shortage is starting to get real for Americans

More than half of all Americans say they've directly felt the effects of health care worker shortages, from canceled appointments to delayed surgeries, according to results from a CVS Health-Harris Poll National Health project provided to Axios.

**Why it matters:** Americans are starting to feel the impacts of the medical workforce crunch as they rearrange their care in the wake of the pandemic, leading to an even bigger supply-demand mismatch and the access issues that come with it.



## 4. Nurse shortfall to hit 250K in 3 years: report

**The U.S. may have a shortfall** of between 250,000 and 450,000 nurses for direct patient care within three years, about 10% to 20% less than what it needs, [according to a new report from McKinsey](#).

**What's happening:** The available labor force was already shrinking due to an aging population and shifting sites of care, but the pandemic accelerated shortages, McKinsey said.

- Meanwhile, demand for nursing services continues to rise due to the pandemic and its aftereffects, plus an aging population.

**What they're saying:** "To meet this demand, the United States would need to more than double the number of new graduates entering and staying in the nursing workforce every year for the next three years straight," the report says.


